Searches room to find hose		
Follows hose until a coupling is located		
Using hands, firefighter examines coupling to detect female and male couplings and verbally identifies each		
Moves from female to male coupling following hose to exterior		
Appropriate time from locating coupling and exiting room (within 5 minutes)

Passes through obstruction in line with SCBA		
Firefighter re-dons SCBA completely/correctly		
All straps fastened and tightened		
Face piece remains on and in use throughout

Completely removes SCBA without releasing grip of left side shoulder strap and regulator hose		
Holding SCBA at back plate, moves SCBA over/under obstruction		
Maintains grip on left shoulder strap and regulator hose		
Passes through obstruction successfully		
Once past, firefighter re-dons SCBA completely/correctly		
All straps fastened and tightened		
Face piece remains on and in use throughout
