Mandatory Sexual Harassment Training – Sept. 4, 2019

New York State has mandated a new sexual harassment training, which must be completed by all members and employees by October 9, 2019. To comply with this mandate, the Jonesville Fire District will be offering an interactive sexual harassment training webinar on Wednesday, Sept. 4, 2019 in the Training Room at Station 1. Please make every effort to attend this webinar and if you cannot, please notify the District Office so we can make alternative arrangement for you to complete the training by the October 9th deadline.

Annual Physicals, Fit Tests and Lab Draw

If you have not had your blood drawn for lab work for you annual physical, you will need to go to Occupational Medicine OM (2388 Rt. 9, Malta) during the week. They open at 8 a.m. M-F and you need to call 518-886-5412 to make any appointment or you can go to Malta Emergent Care at Exit 12 (open 7 days/week starting at 7 a.m.) to have your blood drawn preferably 3 days before your physical. Please tell them your information is in the "Medicon" system.

Evening Physical appointments have been blocked for <u>Wednesday Sept. 18th from 4:30 -6:50 p.m. at</u> Occupational Medicine in Malta. Urine drug screening will be done at annual physicals for all members.

- 1. Please call the district office at 877-8100 to schedule a physical for Sept. 18th. For any other dates, please call Occupational Medicine at 518-886-5412 to schedule a physical date that is convenient for you.
- 2. You will be asked the following questions by the scheduler.
 - Is it for an annual physical or new member?
 - Are you an EMT or plan to become an EMT?
 - Are you a driver (vehicle operations) or plan to be a driver of <u>any</u> apparatus/trucks OM will honor DOT cards previously issued.
- 3. Medical History forms are available online (saratogacare.org) or in the District Office or at time of physicals.
- 4. Please get your lab work done at least 3 days before your appointment. You should be fasting at least 8 hours.
- 5. Fit Tests will be done on site at Station 1 on the same dates, so you do not need to take your SCBA masks to your physicals.
- 6. Deadline to receive your Physical Clearance is November 1, 2019.
- 7. All members in the following categories will need to get an annual physical: Interior, Exterior, Fire Police and Support. <u>Exception: if you are a new member in 2019, you do not</u> <u>have to get another physical this year.</u>

Fit Tests dates: Sept. 18th starting at 5 p.m.

No appointment necessary but bring your SCBA masks. If you cannot make either of these dates, please contact Bill Adams.

<u>From the District Office</u> <u>Defensive Driving Course – Reimbursement</u>

The Board of Fire Commissioners approved reimbursement up to \$40 for a six-hour defensive driving course taken within 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ - 3-year intervals by active firefighters and district staff members. Courses can be taken through any accredited agency or online (e.g. Idrivesafely.com). To receive reimbursement, please submit a copy of the certificate and a copy of the invoice.
